- **Mapped Drive:** Accessing files via the mapped drive is like accessing any other folder or hard disk drive on the computer: search, open, move, copy, rename, delete files just like any other file. Egnyte now supports these capabilities on Windows 8.
- **Mobile Apps:** Users can access files on their mobile devices in two ways: by using a standard mobile web browser or using Egnyte's mobile applications. Now with support for Windows Mobile 8, the Egnyte mobile app not only lets users create, access, manage, share and edit files, but also download files locally on their mobile device for offline access.
